

Wario — Solution

9-Volt

Each of the sets of Hanafuda card contains 1-4 cards of the 4 cards corresponding to one of the months. Indexing into the month name by the number of cards in the set yields the answer **PLATEAU**.

- 2 April = P
- 3 July = L
- 1 August = A
- 4 September = T
- 2 February = E
- 2 January = A
- 2 June = U

Ashley

Each symbol has one or more components with values that can be added to form a number. Line from the center point = 1, line on the outside = 4, circle = 10. Converting the numbers at the bottom to letters (A=1, etc.) gives **SILENT AUCTION**.

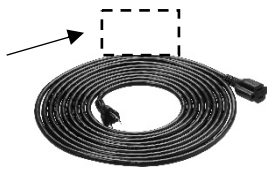

Dribble & Spitz

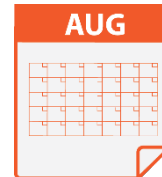
Each image clues a word or phrase that's a US state capital with a single letter removed. The removed letters spell **COAUTHOR**.



(C) ON CORD



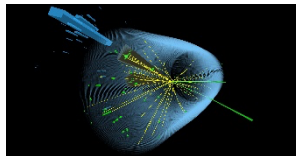

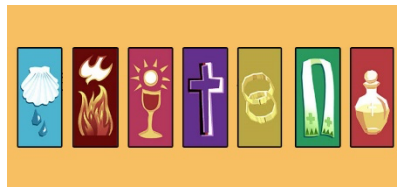

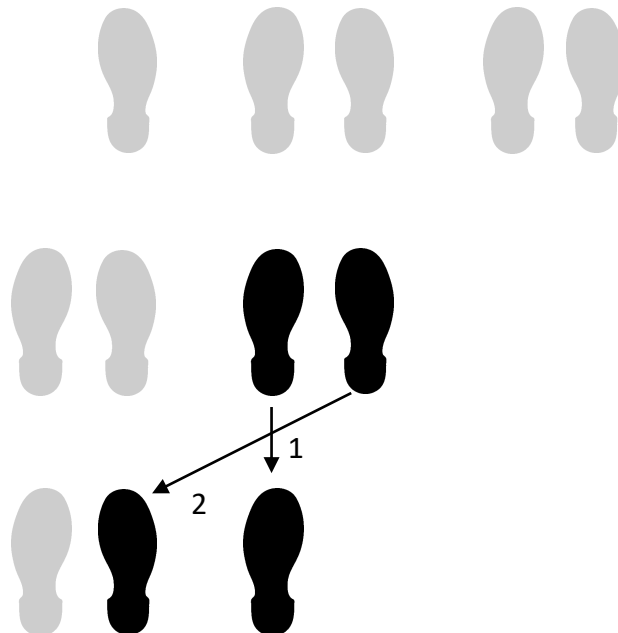

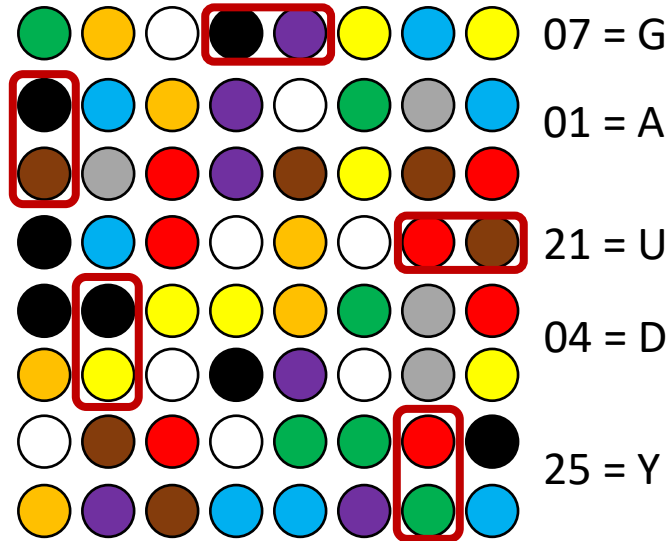
Jimmy T

Each two steps in the diagram move the left and right feet to different positions around the center starting point. Interpreting each pair as a Semaphore letter, using the start point as the center, spells **APPLAUD**.



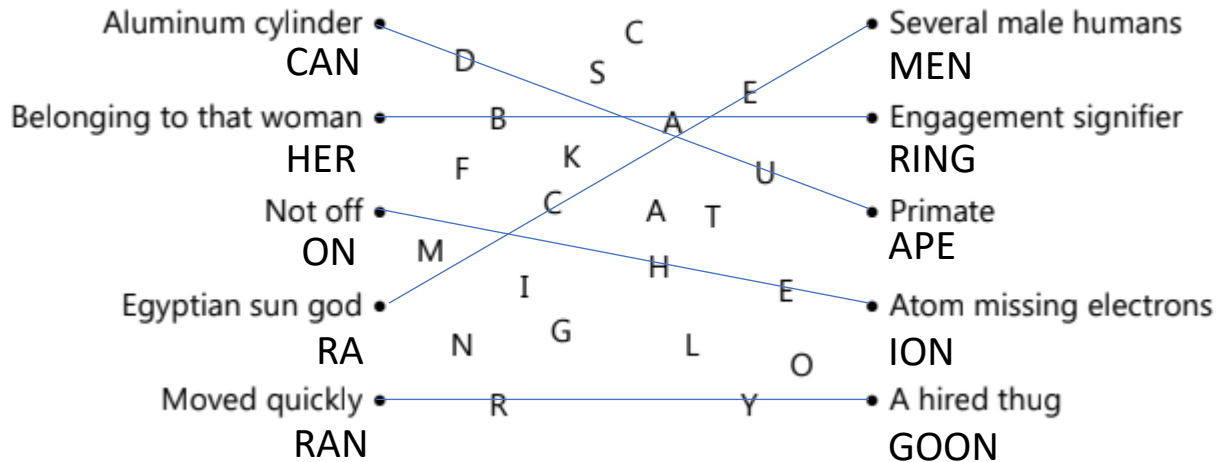
Mona

Treating this like a match-3 puzzle game like Bejeweled (switch two adjacent circles to make a matching row or column of three), there are exactly five valid moves. Converting the two gems used in each to numbers via resistor colors to letters, and reading top to bottom, spells **GAUDY**.



Orbulon

The answers to the clues on each side can be paired off to make words that when combined form a food item. The letters crossed by the lines doing so spell **DEBAUCHERY**.



Wario (Meta)

Each answer contains AU – “Gold” clued by the reference to Wario’s latest game. Ordering by the position of AU in the word, and reading the letter before the AU, yields the final answer, **GOBLET**.
